

EUGEN WÖRLE

- 1909 born in Bregenz on 3 January
- 1919 – 1923 attended the Cistercian College at Mereau on the Lake of Constance
- 1923 – 1927 Staatsgewerbeschule Innsbruck
- 1927 – 1930 Studied at the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna, under Clemens Holzmeister (Hansen Prize, Masterclass Prize)
- 1930 – 1934 worked in the office of Ernst Lichtblau
- 1932 – 1936 worked in the office of Clemens Holzmeister, simultaneous freelance work in collaboration with Paul Wörle and Max Fellerer
- 1932 Hotel Tulbingerkogel (with Max Fellerer)
- 1934 – 1957 office partnership with Max Fellerer
- from 1935 member of the Zentralvereinigung der ArchitektInnen Österreichs
- 1937 Candies sweetshop, 1010 Vienna
- 1940 development plan, Melk
- 1942 – 1945 conscripted to the Flugmotorenwerke Ostmark and to the Flugzeugwerk Henkel, various planning projects
- 1942 death of his brother Paul Wörle
- 1945 – 1957 reopened his office partnership with Fellerer
- 1947 – 1951 Per Albin-Hansson housing estate (with Max Fellerer, Friedrich Pangratz, Franz Schuster and Stephan Simony), 1100 Vienna
- from 1957 ran his own office in Vienna following the death of Max Fellerer
- 1948 – 1950 Am Gänsehäufel outdoor bathing facility (with Max Fellerer), 1220 Vienna
- 1951 – 1953 Haas-Haus, 1010 Vienna (with Max Fellerer and Carl Appel)
- 1954 – 1961 Parkhotel Mirabell, Salzburg (with Max Fellerer and Felix Hasenöhrli)
- 1955 – 1956 rebuilding of the Parliament building, 1010 Vienna (with Max Fellerer and Carl Appel)
- 1956 Architecture Prize of the City of Vienna
- from 1961 President of the Ingenieurkammer (Chamber of Civil Engineers)
- 1963 Austrian State Prize for Architecture
- 1967 – 1969 Goldene Stiege housing complex, Mödling
- from 1967 President of the Zentralvereinigung der ArchitektInnen Österreichs
- 1996 died in Vienna on 14 December
