The Architekturzentrum Wien turns 20! There is good reason to celebrate, as in the past two decades the Az W has secured a name for itself both nationally and internationally as an important competence centre for modern and contemporary architecture. We celebrate the fact that the Az W exists in the first place and, hopefully, will continue to exist for a long time to come.

When it was founded back in 1993 the Az W set itself the following goals: presenting, discussing, publishing and archiving architecture. Whereas in the early years the presentation and explanation of architecture was the main focus of activities, today the Az W concentrates also on all the functions of a classic museum: collecting, preserving, and researching. As the only such institution in Austria the Architekturzentrum Wien devotes itself to the intensive processing and preservation of the architectural history of modernism in this country and also serves as an international contact point and interface. A major goal of the Az W is to strengthen public awareness of the need to preserve this cultural legacy. After all, architecture – the design of our environment – influences all areas of life and lastingly shapes our society.

As regards the numbers of visitors, media reports and productivity 2012 was a particularly successful year for the Architekturzentrum Wien. In comparison to the previous year the number of visitors increased by around 14%. A total of 9 exhibitions (3 of which went abroad as travelling exhibitions), 24 events of different kinds, around 440 workshops for children, young people and adults and 95 architecture tours were conceived, organized, and curated.

Sadly however, the anniversary year is overshadowed by the precarious budgetary situation of the Az W. In the present financial and spatial situation the Az W has over the years repeatedly arrived at its limits, as neither the city (since 2001) or the federal state (since 1995) have increased their subsidies or adjusted them to match the rate of inflation. This represents a real annual loss of around 552.465 €. As a result the



constantly growing interest in making bequests and leaving legacies and the increasing need for research into the collections, for educational work and information cannot be met without a clear increase in funding.

The Architekturzentrum Wien is forced to further reduce its programme, destroy successfully established structures and know-how and to reduce staff numbers. An idea of how truly drastic the financial situation actually is can be gained from the fact that we can only make one in-house exhibition per year and for the rest of the time the 'Alte Halle' must be rented out commercially.

Az W GOLD. THE COLLECTION (20.03.) 21.03.–22.07.2013, Alte Halle

The Architekturzentrum Wien turns 20! The right time to put the previously little known Az W collection into the limelight with a special exhibition: a show of the most interesting objects in the collection will make the Az W Gold both visible and accessible from spring 2013. The jubilee exhibition shows documentation of key epochs in the history of Austrian architecture with design drawings, plans, sketchbooks, photographs and models, and invites visitors to cast their gaze over the collected architectural heritage of Austria – as a discovery, as a statement and as reassurance. a_show. AUSTRIAN ARCHITECTURE IN THE 20th AND 21st CENTURIES Permanant Exhbition, Neue Halle

The a_show provides a fascinating voyage of discovery through the history of building and the masterpieces of Austrian architecture over the past 150 years. From visionary landmarks to exceptional insider tips, from Otto Wagner's Postal Savings Bank to Hans Hollein's Retti shop, from Red Vienna to the timber buildings of Vorarlberg, from summer residencies to industrial monuments: the exhibition 'a_show' provides a permanent showcase for the architectural heritage and identity of Austria. 10 episodes: prologue, red vienna, landscape, power, reconstruction, international, system, utopia, collage and the present provide a varied in-depth display of over 400 buildings and sharpen the viewer's perspective on current developments.

GUEST EXHIBITIONS 2013

DAS BESTE HAUS. ARCHITECTURE PRIZE 2013 (24.04.) 25.04.–13.05.2013, Halle F3

This year the prize for 'Das beste Haus' (The Best House) is being organised for the fifth time by the s Bausparkasse in conjunction with the bm:ukk and the Az W. With the help of regional architecture institutions in Austria 'the best House' in each of the country's federal states was selected from a total of 112 entries. Among this year's finalists, which range from a self-build project to a villa, a clear trend towards natural and untreated building materials could be identified. In addition the projects include a greater number of conversions and extensions in which a strong awareness of the contextual agreement of old and new is evident. Harmonious integration in the landscape is also acquiring increasing importance. The prizes for the nine winning projects will be presented at the award ceremony in the Az W. Together with other remarkable nominations they will be shown in an exhibition that will later tour Austria. Information: www.dasbestehaus.at

LINA BO BARDI: TOGETHER (17.05.) 18.05.–12.06.2013, Halle F3

'Lina Bo Bardi: Together' is a film and art installation that celebrates the work of this Italian-born-Brazilian architect who has left an impressive legacy in Brazil. The exhibition – a joint work by curator Noemi Blager, Dutch artist Madelon Vriesendorp and filmmaker Tapio Snellman – concentrates on the way people use Lina Bo Bardi's buildings. It enables visitors to experience her buildings directly and, most importantly, in their urban context. The exhibition design was produced by 'Assemble', a London based design and architecture collective. It reflects Bo Bardi's vision of an architecture of social responsibility and is thus an important part of the exhibition. 'Lina Bo Bardi: Together' was first shown in winter 2012 in the British Council Gallery in London and is now making a European tour. Sponsored by Arper (www.arper.com)

WONDERLAB

(07.08.) 08.08.–26.08.2013, Alte Halle

In 2013 wonderland celebrates its eleven years in existence in the Architekturzentrum Wien. This platform is active throughout Europe and aims at making visible and further intensifying the networking of young architects and the exchange of current tendencies in architecture and urbanism which has been taking



place for more than a decade. In August 2013 the transnational network will consolidate to form a temporary physical wonderland headquarters, the 'wonderlab'. In an interactive work space that grows in accordance with the processes involved young international teams will negotiate a theme of relevance to Vienna – living wonderland and at the same time allowing it to be experienced. The film series 'Movies in Wonderland', the discussion format 'Blind Date', and lectures etc. provide additional input. Parallel to this the wonderland archive shows material from earlier activities and brings together the knowledge acquired in the past years. This exhibition, curated by Dieter Ronte und Florian Medicus and set up by NEW FRONTIERS, an association for the promotion of experimental architecture, presents a selection of current architecture drawings from Austria as a basis for critical reflection on digital and virtual planning processes as well as the artistic circumstances under which architecture is made. The selection of the works exhibited comes for the most part from an Austrian competition and thus offers a high-quality overview of drawing and the 'processing of space' per se. One third of Vienna's urban growth takes place in the Donaustadt. What images of the city are projected onto this space? Does more growth always mean more city? And what contribution does the 'Seestadt' make in this 'terrain vague'? In a number of expeditions, lectures and salon discussions held in the context of the event series 'Zukunft Stadt' organised by the Centre of Local Planning at the TU Vienna in recent months an approach was made to the transformation space Donaustadt in order to discern its qualities and autonomy and to examine its design possibilities. At the conclusion of the series the Centre extends an invitation to the symposium 'Zukunft Stadt Positionen' in order to examine the phenomenon Donaustadt and to take a position.

INTERIEURS. FILM SCREENING AND DISCUSSION 26.04.2013, Az W Podium

Gold Tour 1: The Gold Trail 06.04.2013, 2 pm – 5 pm

In cooperation with radio Ö1, the Az W is offering a guided tour of four enthralling projects from its world class collection: from the Ebendorferstrasse chapel by Ottokar Uhl past the Austrian Parliament rebuilt by Fellerer & Wörle and the Herrengasse high-rise by Theiss & Jaksch to the Volksgarten Pavillion by Oswald Haerdtl.

Gold Tour 2: House Calls 21.04.2013, 2 pm – 6 pm

As part of the focus on the collection, the Az W visits the homes of Hans Puchhammer and Gertrude Uhl in the Mauerbergsiedlung, which is a pioneering achievement in high-density low-rise building by Roland Rainer. Following this visit, Hans Puchhammer and Gunther Wawrik accompany the group to a residence that they have designed themselves.

Gold Tour 3: The Depot 05.05.2013, 2 pm - 6 pm

The Az W Depot is housed in a former metal factory in Möllersdorf. This is where the architectural heritage of Austria is stored in the form of thousands of plans, models and documents. The guided tour provides a



unique insight into the 'Az W Gold'. The route to the depot runs past two insiders' tips: Möllersdorf parish church by Carl Auböck, and the Traiskirchen protestant nchurch by Theiss & Jaksch.

Gold Tour 4: The Highlights 09.06.2013, 10 am - ca. 5.30 pm

The guided tour provides a unique opportunity to experience the highlights of the Az W Collection first-hand, on location. The tour leads to milestones in the architectural history of Vienna after 1945: Kinkplatz school by Helmut Richter, Baumgartner Spitz Pastoral Center by Johann Georg Gsteu, Küniglberg ORF Centre by Roland Rainer, Am Schöpfwerk by Viktor Hufnagl, Salvatorkirche church by Johannes Spalt, and Raum Zita Kern by Artec Architekten.
