archdiploma 13

Within the framework of archdiploma 13, a topical selection of the last two years' best diploma theses is presented. In the course of the exhibition the extraordinary scope of subjects explored by the two study fields, architecture and spatial design, is made visible. All approaches presented here structure or furnish our cultivated environment, thus being societally most relevant. Debates are taking place on totally different standards, the explicit reference to the environment being the essential basis in architectural planning: designs are visualised in form of models, books and on interactive screens, theoretical theses are presented in hardback and on tablets.

The location of the exhibition which will take place from October 16th - 26th 2013 is the Alte Halle of the Architekturzentrum Wien. Graduates are given the opportunity to present themselves and their work – design and theory projects as well as experimental and spatial planning projects – to an interested public.

At the archdiploma 13 exhibition a catalogue under the same name will be available in German and English, it includes extensive articles and illustrations for individual projects.

Exhibition Concept

The simplistic exhibition system meets the needs of different media and scales in a simple manner: it is organised in three alignments and filled with models, screens and books. The system offers sheltered spaces, spatially defined islands — inviting to deepen one's exploration of the theoretical theses. Visitors experience an organic spatial situation in which wide expanses and narrow, pathlike spaces alternate, thus resembling our urban environment. The diversity of theses proves the intensity architecture and planning issues are debated with. To such debates great societal relevance is inherent.

Awards

The exhibition opening is marked by the Faculty's awarding archdiploma`13 prizes for excellent diploma theses which have been determined in a pre-selection process by a panel of experts. During the closing ceremony the audience prize will also be awarded.

archdiploma

The archdiploma was initiated by Klaus Semsroth, the previous Dean of the Faculty of Architecture and Planning at the Vienna UT, in the year 2000. Since then it has taken place bi-annually so the autumn of 2013 will see it's 8th appearance. Its curators alternate each time, they come from the architecture faculty, every archdiploma therefore displays its own unique signature. This form of individuality reflects the expression of diverse standpoints and views characterising the study of architecture at the Vienna UT. Public interest has been considerable since its beginning, in 2011 more than 6000 interested guests visited the exhibition.
