Presentation of the prize-winning photos from 06.11. - 01.12.2014 in the Az W Shop

On 5 November 2014 the Architekturzentrum Wien announced the prize-winners and the special mentions in this year's Az W Photo Award. For a period of three weeks the photographs can be viewed in the framework of Eyes-On, the Month of Photography in the Architekturzentrum Wien.

The theme "Think Global, Build Social" inspired the entrants for the competition to submit a wide range of very different views of architecture's social agenda. Humankind plays a central role and in some cases is more present, in others less. Where people are missing from the image the viewer is invited to look for their traces. And in many cases there are more of these than you might at first glance suspect....
